The Hinesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (HAMPO) is applying for funding assistance under Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5303 of the Federal Transit Act pertaining to metropolitan planning organizations.

HAMPO is the metropolitan planning organization for the Hinesville Metropolitan Planning Area consisting of urbanized Long County, Liberty County, Fort Stewart Military Reservation, the Town of Allenhurst, and the Cities of Flemington, Gum Branch, Hinesville, Midway, Riceboro and Walthourville.

HAMPO solicits comments and concerns from local government agencies, interested parties, and residents on transportation planning activities. HAMPO also solicits and comments and concerns from the elderly, low-income, and disabled populations, and their representatives to assure that issues related to these populations are addressed during the metropolitan planning process.
