 - Two new buses expected to arrive second week in May



Liberty Transit Development Plan









b. Transit Updates

- Paratransit ridership has been lower than the previous year's ridership since July 2022
- Systemwide trips per revenue service hours decreased sharply from Feb. to March, but is still higher than previous years ratio
- Route I was the only route to show increased ridership (by 10.9%)
- Systemwide trips decreased by 8.9% from March 2022 to March 2023 (1,218 to 1,109 total trips)




- Policy Committee meets in June to release the draft FY 2024 –
