b. Transit Updates

- System Highlights:
 - Liberty Transit is continuing to meet with partners regarding TDP implementation
 - Vanpool program implementation planning is underway.
 - Service to Walthourville is being discontinued starting December 31, 2025



Ridership over past 3 months averaging +/- 2,321 (higher than last year's average of 1,547)



Paratransit ridership reached new peak of 1,174 in September (previous peak was 981 in July)

- Comment 2025-01
 - **Source:** CAC Member transmitted letter from a concerned citizen.
 - **Location:** Kings Road adjacent to Snelson Golden Middle School in Hinesville
 - **Summary of Comment:**
 - Vehicles using Kings Road as drop-off location for students entering school property via pedestrian bridge.
 - Roadway condition is poor and lacks sufficient infrastructure (sidewalks, etc.) making the increased traffic unsafe.
 - Increased traffic is unfavorable to residents.

TCC BYLAWS:ARTICLE IV

Officers and Organization

- 1) The Technical Coordinating Committee shall select a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson from among its members. Such selection shall be by a majority vote.
- 2) In the absence of both the Chairperson and the Vice-Chairperson, the members present for the meeting shall designate, by majority vote, a member to temporarily assume the responsibilities of the Chairpersons for the purpose of conducting the official business of the Committee.
- 3) Selection of the Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall take place on the first meeting of the calendar year at which there is a majority of voting members present.
- 4) The term of Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson shall be for the calendar year.
- 5) Officers may succeed themselves with no limitation to the number of terms, except that such term will not continue in the event an officer becomes ineligible to be a member of the Policy Committee.

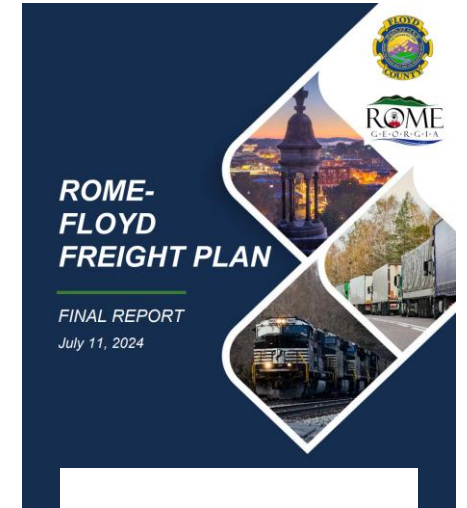
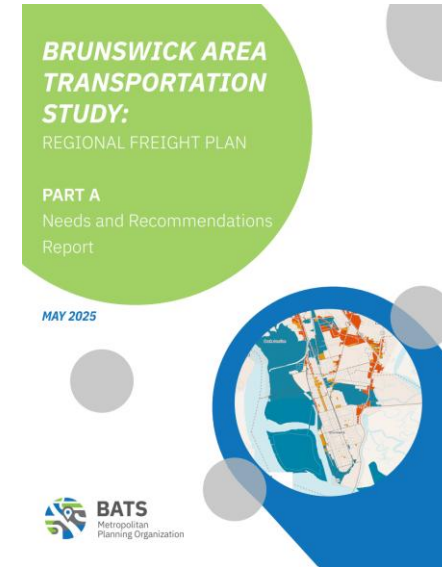
