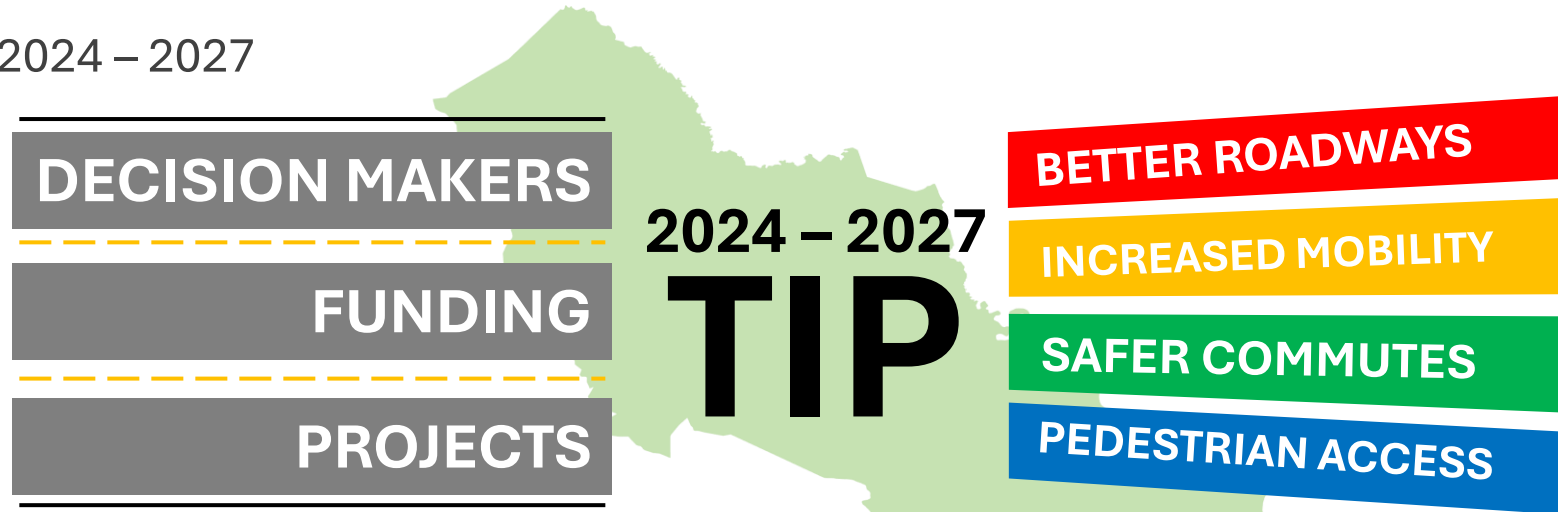

- Current TIP 2024 – 2027

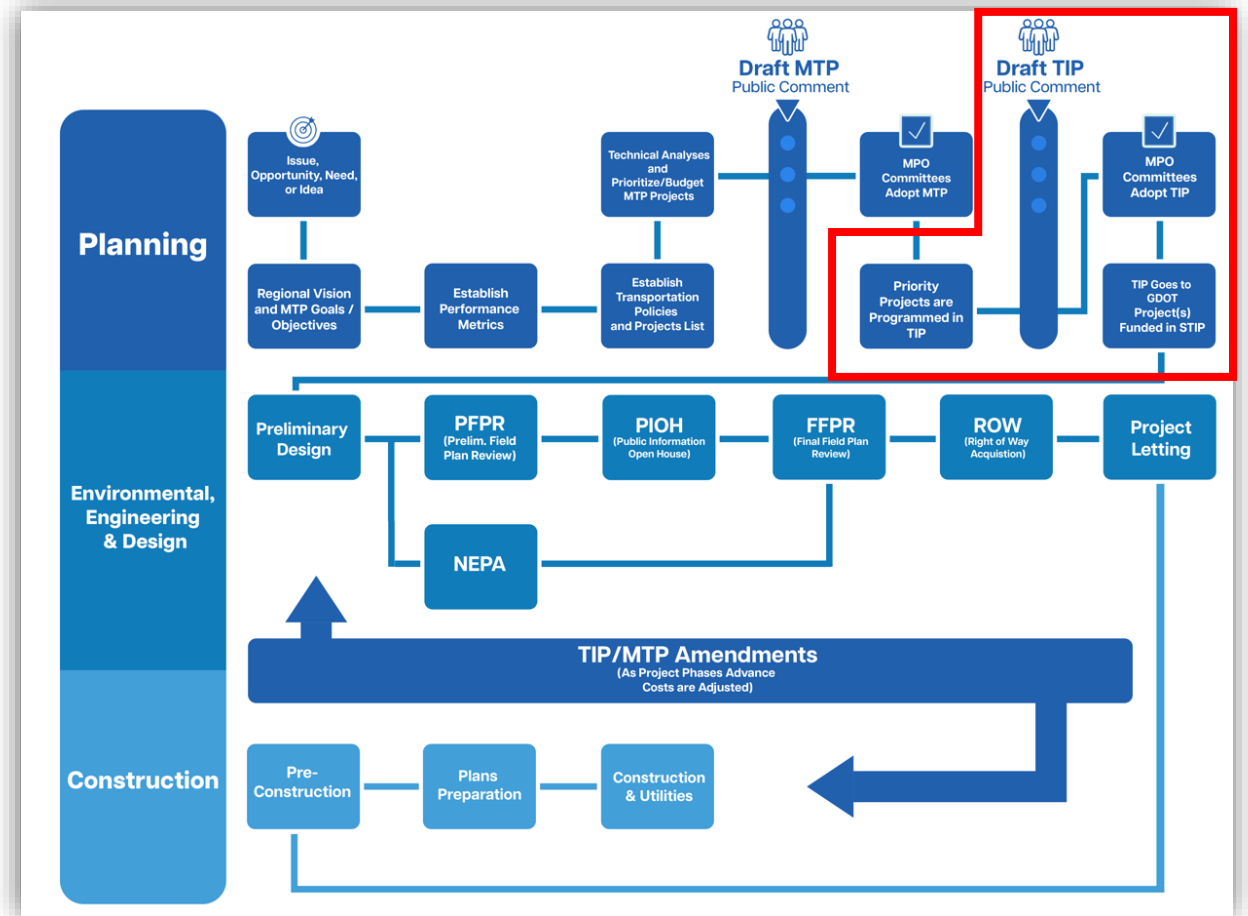

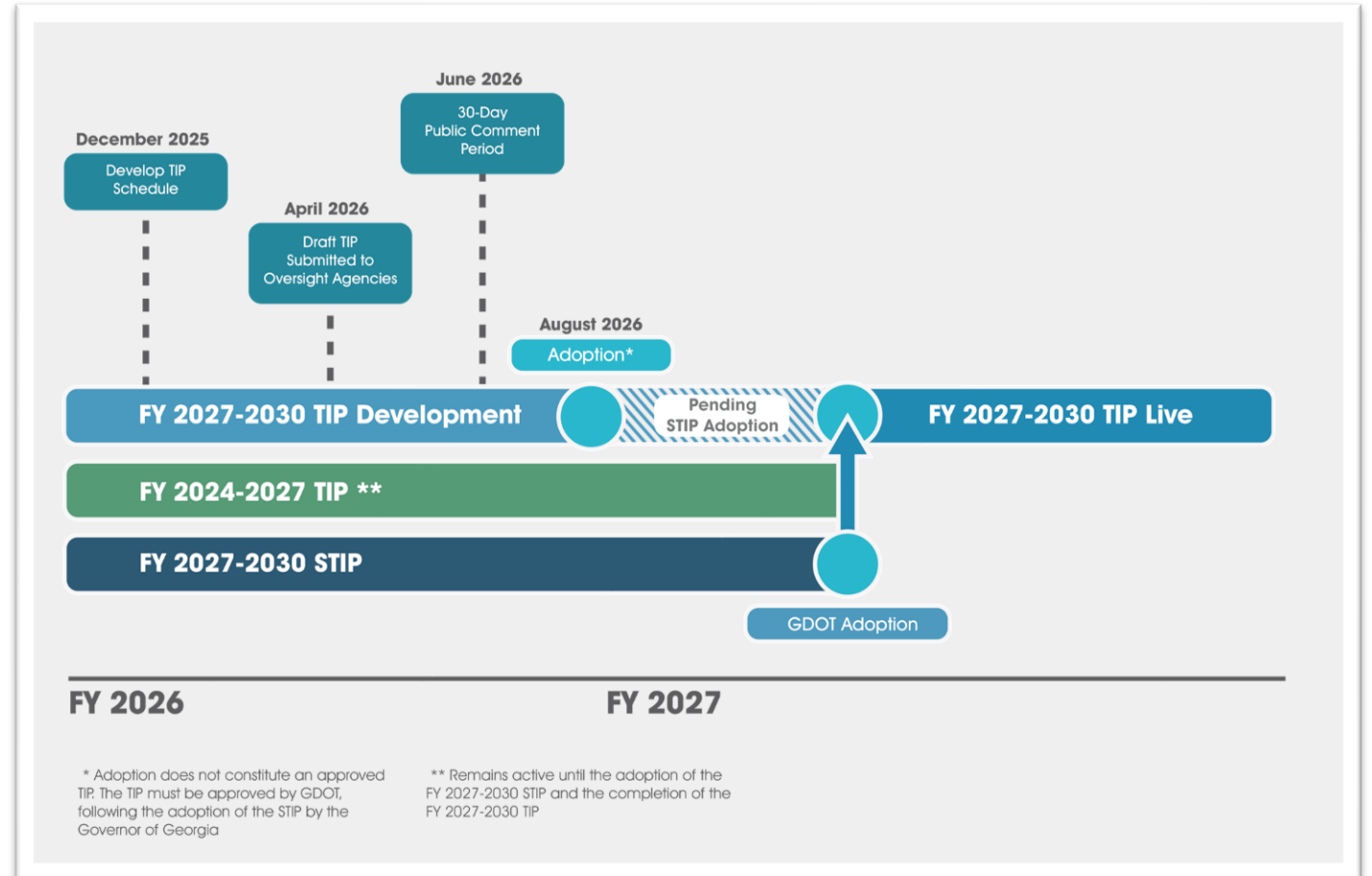

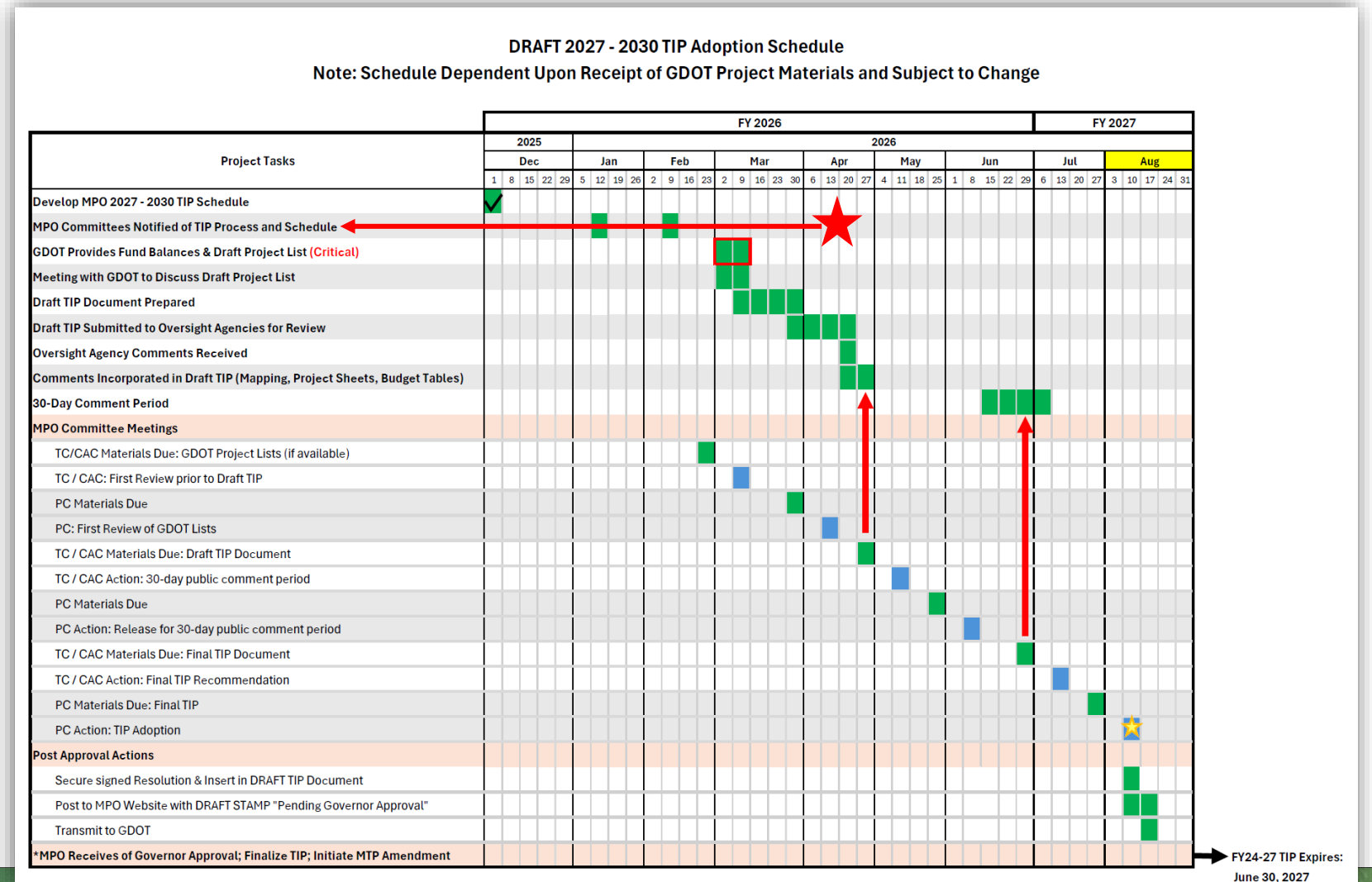

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT BACKGROUND, NEED & GOALS:

HAMPO updated the 2050 MTP in August 2025 with a discussion on freight, but not a detailed analysis on the real impact of freight in our community. The 2017 HAMPO Regional Freight Plan was the last detailed look at freight in the HAMPO region. On December 11, 2025, HAMPO's Policy Committee by resolution approved application for supplemental PL funds for a Regional Freight Plan Update with an estimated cost of \$250,000 (\$50,000 local, \$200,00 federal).

c. Carbon Reduction Funds Program – Informational Item

- Background and Previous Action
 - 2021: IJJA established the Carbon Reduction Program. Administered by the FHWA, the program provides \$6.4 billion in formula funding over five years for states to develop carbon reduction strategies and for projects to reduce transportation carbon dioxide emissions.
 - 2023: GDOT coordinated with MPOs for feedback on draft Carbon Reduction Strategy
 - 2024: FHWA reviewed GDOT Carbon Reduction Strategy and issued certification
 - 2025: HAMPO selected Liberty Transit ADA Accessibility Project for initial programmed funding
- FY 2026 HAMPO Action Items
 - Identify Eligible Projects
 - Prioritize / Select Candidate Projects
 - Coordinate with Oversight Agencies for Programming of Funds
 - Amend project(s) into 2024 – 2027 TIP
 - Obligate funds before they lapse!

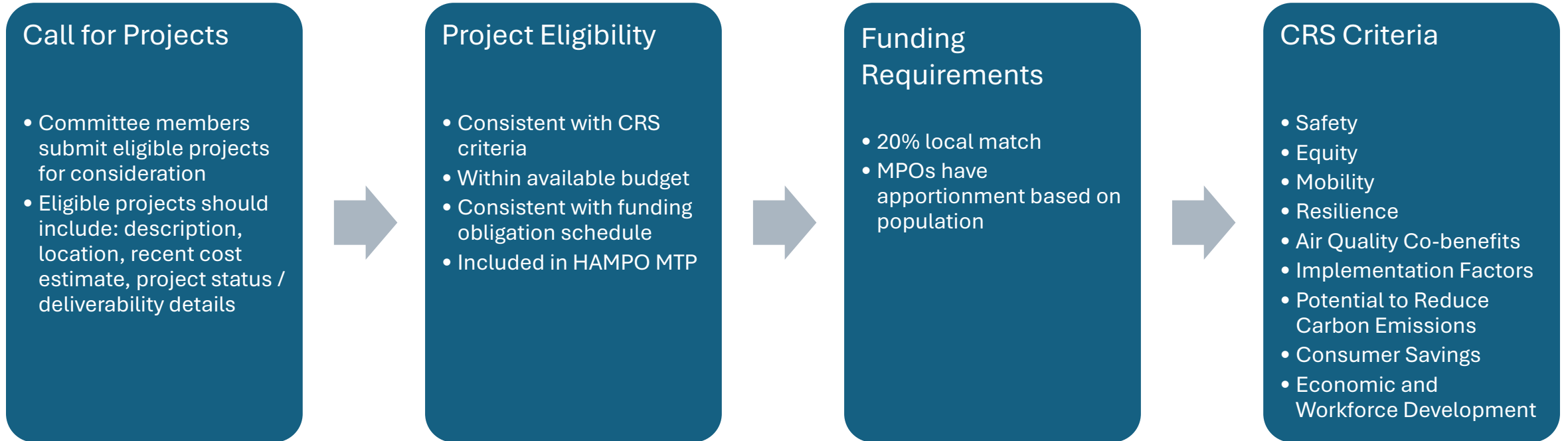
