Safety Performance Report Update

- HAMPO staff received the Georgia MPO FY27-30 MPO SPR on May 29th from GDOT Planning
- Includes federal performance measures and statewide performance targets set by GDOT
 - PM1: Highway Safety
 - PM2: Pavement and Bridge Condition on Georgia’s Interstates and non-Interstate National Highway System
 - PM3: System Performance, Freight, and Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality Improvement Program
- HAMPO staff is currently updating SPR
- Will be included as administrative modification to 2050 MTP, and incorporated directly into FY27-30 TIP

Carbon Reduction Program Funds Update

- Policy Committee voted at June PC meeting to approve both applications for CRP funding
 - Full amount of CRP funding for the Interstate 95 Highway 84 Street Light Replacement project

- Additional funds will be sought to fund remaining portion of S. Main St. project

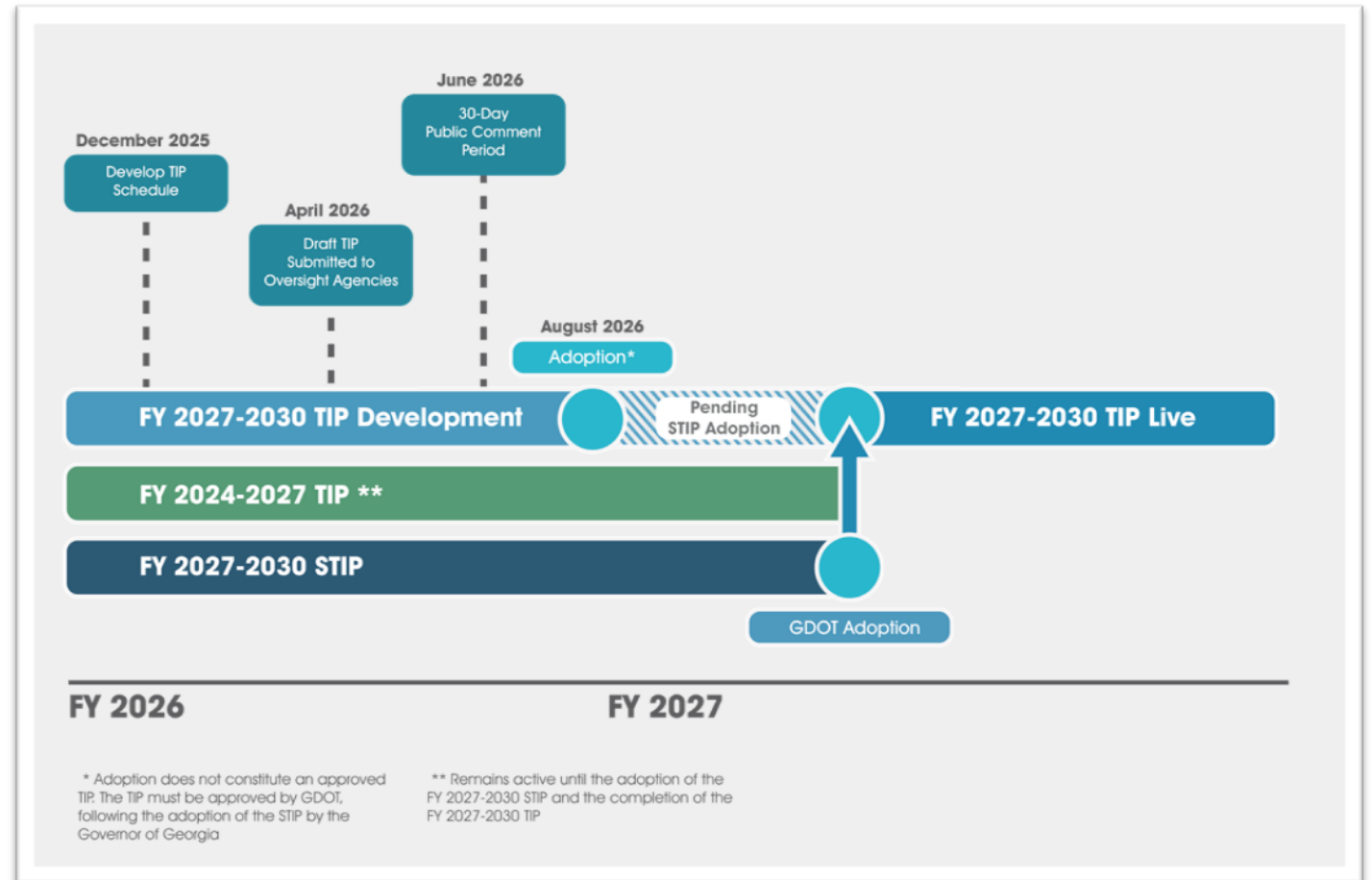

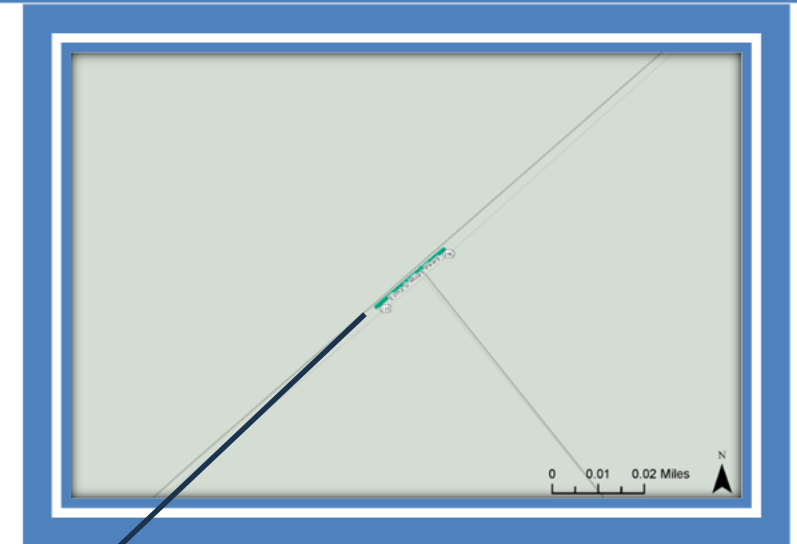
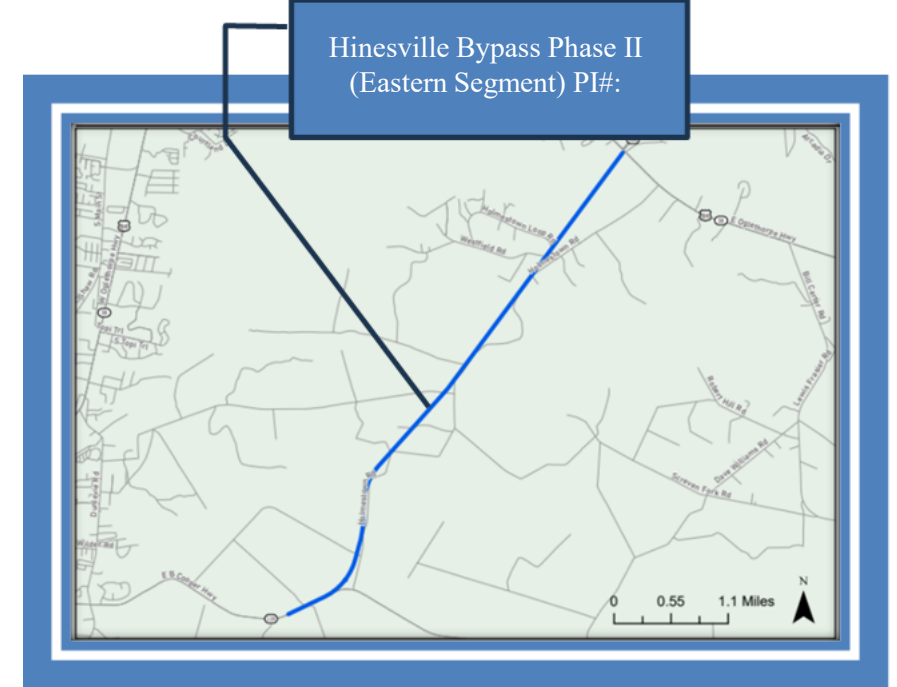
