

RESOLUTION OF THE HINESVILLE AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN FUNDED BY THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT

WHEREAS, the Hinesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (HAMPO) has been designated by the Governor of the State of Georgia as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for conducting transportation planning activities in the Hinesville Metropolitan Planning Area consisting of urbanized Long County, Liberty County, Fort Stewart Military Reservation, the Town of Allenhurst, and the Cities of Flemington, Gum Branch, Hinesville, Midway, Riceboro and Walthourville; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) launched the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) program to support local, regional, and Tribal initiatives to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the Hinesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (HAMPO) was awarded funding through the SS4A grant program in 2024 to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP); and

WHEREAS, the HAMPO, local stakeholders, technical professionals, and members of the public have collaboratively developed a data-driven and equitable Comprehensive Safety Action Plan in accordance with the United States Department of Transportation's requirements for the SS4A program; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan establishes a framework to address specific safety needs and reduce traffic fatalities within the Hinesville Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets for All planning framework will enhance the public health, safety, and welfare of the traveling public within the Hinesville Metropolitan Planning Area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Policy Committee of the Hinesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization approves its Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Policy Committee of the Hinesville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization authorizes the Liberty Consolidated Planning Commission Executive Director to transmit the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Comprehensive Safety Action Plan to the Georgia Department of Transportation to secure state and federal transportation planning funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Liberty Consolidated Planning Commission Executive Director is further authorized to pursue additional grant funding opportunities to implement recommendations identified within the approved Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.
